What Will Happen During the Event?

During the programme, participants will take part in expert-led sessions, discussions and exchanges of good practices. The agenda will focus on public spaces, local participation, community well-being and the role of towns in shaping more sustainable urban environments.

The event will also create space for networking and informal exchange, allowing participants to share their perspectives, learn from one another and strengthen the connections between the BioBOND partner communities.

Throughout the event, participants will be invited to reflect on questions such as:

- How can public spaces become more welcoming and sustainable?
- What can towns learn from each other's local experiences?
- How can citizens be more actively involved in shaping their communities?
- How can European cooperation support practical local action?
